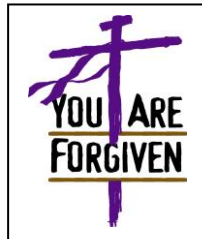

RCYC Registrations are now being accepted!!

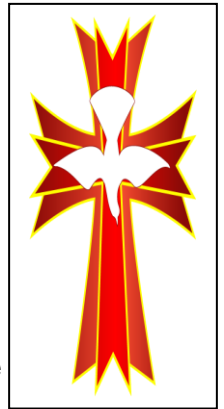
