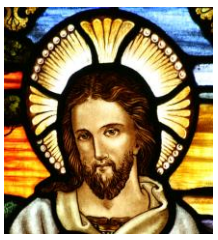

Is St. Paul crazy? On face value, it seems that St. Paul says that marriage is an obstacle to personal holiness? What does that mean?
