**Masses: 6:00pm – St. Francis Xavier  
7:30pm – St. Patrick**

**Lenten Fasting** – on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, all Catholics (in good health) between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast – taking only one meal, (two smaller meals may be eaten if needed to maintain strength.) No snacking between meals.

**Lenten Abstinence** – on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent, all Catholics (in good health), 14yrs of age and older, are to abstain from eating meat.

**No Catholic should excuse her/himself lightly from keeping the fast and abstinence of Lent**

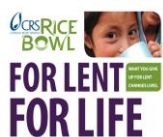

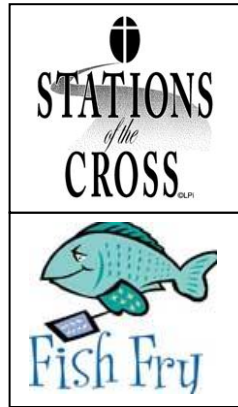
