We often view joy as an emotion that comes upon us during favorable times and circumstances, such as winning the lottery. But this is not the way Jesus understood it.

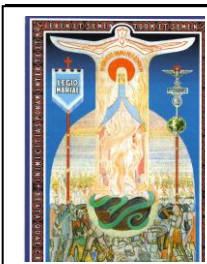
