'Speak to the Israelite community and tell them: Be holy, for I, the Lord, your God, am holy.'"*

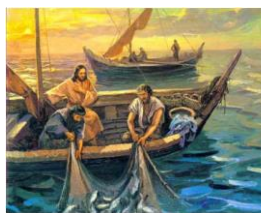
*"Brothers and sisters: Do you not know that you are the temple of God,

Faith Minute.....

How do we view happiness?

Do we wait for others to “make” us happy?

Happiness should be something that comes from within. But how do we cultivate happiness in our lives?

To understand this better, Pope Francis has a few ideas about praying and proceeding calmly in life. Here is part of his reflection for you.....

Happiness is often jeopardized when our lives become hectic and out of control. I like to use the image of a quiet pool of water and urge you “to move with kindness and humility, with a calmness in life.” In trying to cultivate this calmness in life, it is important for you to understand that life is not governed so much by what happens to you as it is by how you react to disruptive influences.

The Pope maintains that one way to calmness - no matter what is happening – is to establish a deep spiritual life of prayer.

“When we are centered on and in God, what happens on the surface of our lives may ruffle us a little, but it will not disturb our calm, inner peace. So pray, pray.....pray.”

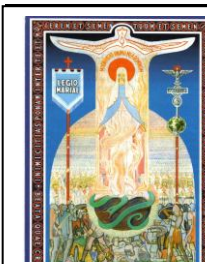
