In the Gospel today, we hear Jesus tell Peter to “feed my sheep”. How are we fed today? We rejoice in receiving the gift of the sacrifice of the Mass which is our Lord in Holy Eucharist. We can reflect on the fruits of receiving the Eucharist which have been opened to us and to all who come to receive with an open heart.

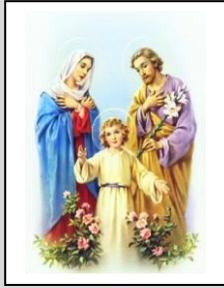

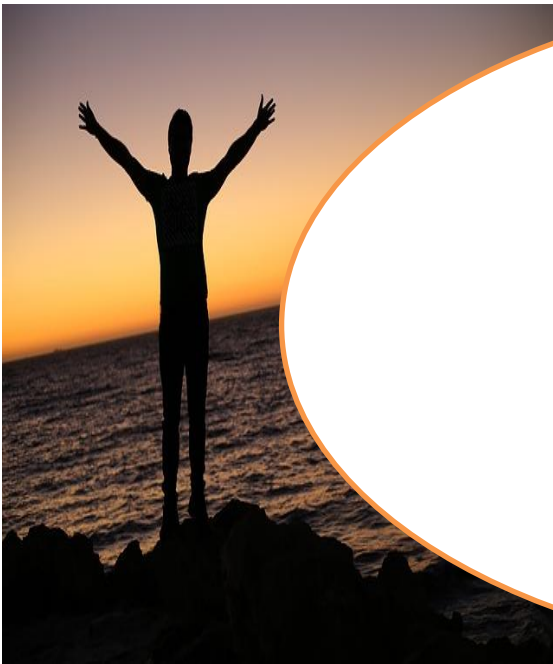
