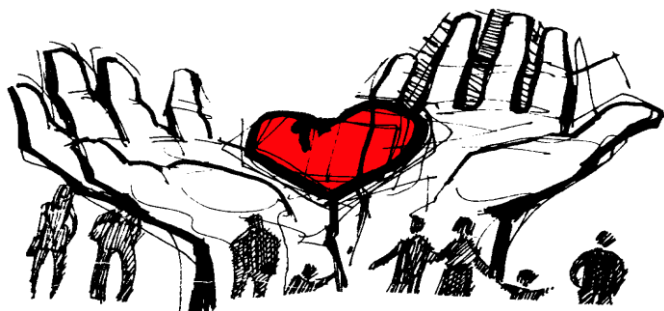

Thank you in advance for all who will help with this great event.

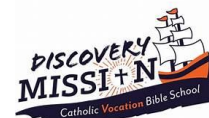
Summer VBS
