A message from Father Quentin...

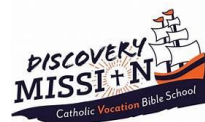
Summer VBS

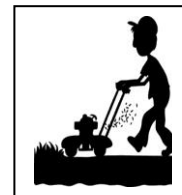

If we look to the Bible, Jesus clues us into the mission for every married couple. Jesus sends his disciples out 2 by 2 to proclaim the Kingdom of God, which means they were sent to announce the presence of God among us.

With Sacramental Marriage, the couple becomes the presence of God in the community as the sign of Christ's love for the Church. God's plan for every married couple is to bring His life and love into the local community through the way they love one another.
