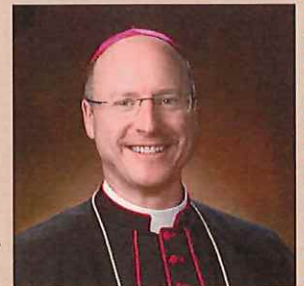


Archbishop McKnight's Fresh Start Food & Supply Drive benefitting Catholic Charities

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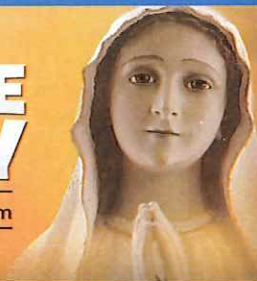
