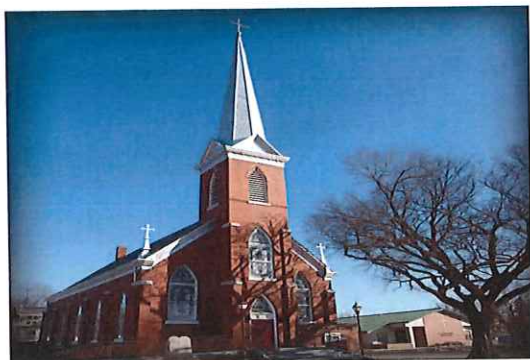
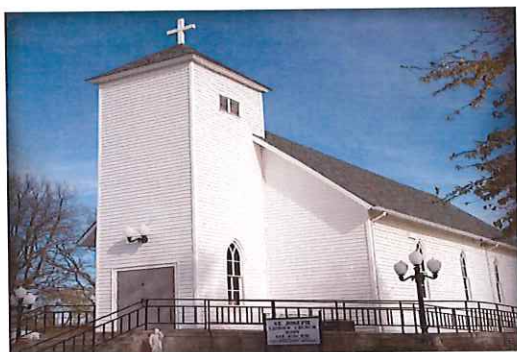

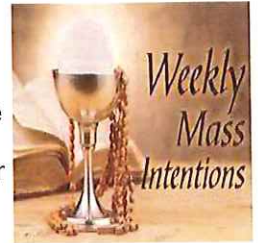

What is the Angelus?

The Angelus is a devotion commemorating the Incarnation of Jesus. The devotion was traditionally recited in Roman Catholic churches, convents, and monasteries three times daily at 6am, noon and 6pm. The devotion can now be done as a group or even privately in your home or at work.

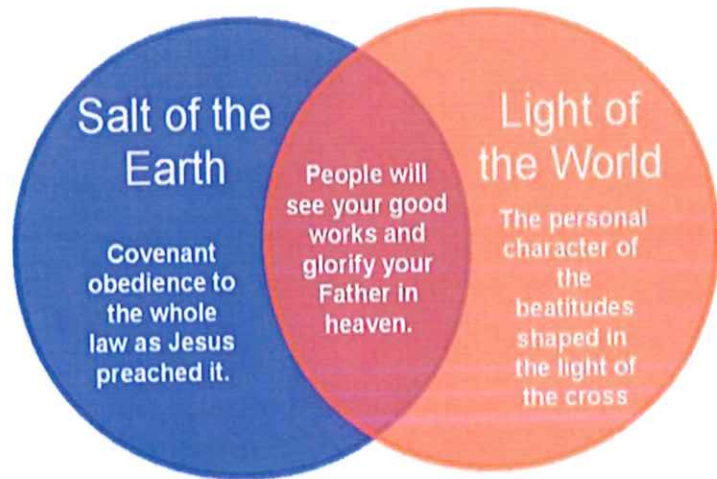
