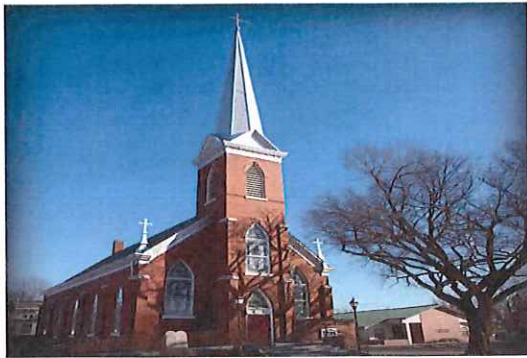
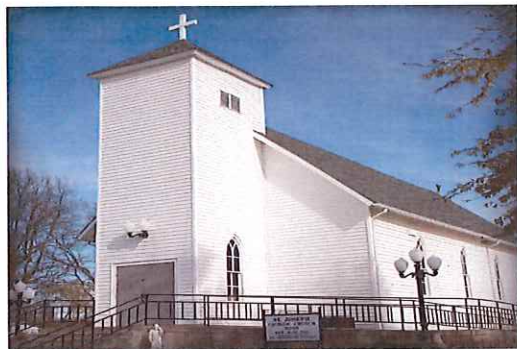

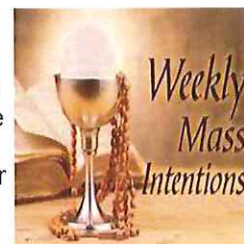

Welcome to Fr. George Rhodes

Fr. Rhodes was born and raised in Olathe, the second of four children of Jason and Kathy Rhodes. As a young boy he went to the 7:30am Sunday Mass every week with his family and was an almost weekly altar server with his brothers.



Fr. Rhodes attended St. James Academy in Lenexa where the idea of the priesthood came to the surface and stayed with him. His discernment led him to the Seminary at Kenrick-Glennon in St. Louis, where he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy in 2018, and a Master's of Divinity in 2023. He was ordained into the priesthood by Archbishop Naumann on May 27, 2023 at Prince of Peace Church in Olathe.

Fr. Rhodes said his favorite saint is John the Baptist because he lived his entire life pointing to Christ. His favorite devotion is the Stations of the Cross because Christ won all sanctifying grace in his passion, so it's important to meditate on it regularly. His favorite food is sushi and he enjoys running in his leisure time. In his priestly ministry Fr. Rhodes looks forward to witnessing God's grace at work in peoples' lives. He said he wanted to be a priest because not only has God called him to it, but it is a great privilege and joy to minister to his people.

Fr. Rhodes has been Parochial Vicar of Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Church in Topeka and the chaplain of Cor Christi Catholic Center at Washburn University. We will welcome Fr. Rhodes to our parishes beginning Oct 31st. We ask that you continue to pray for him and for all of our priests.

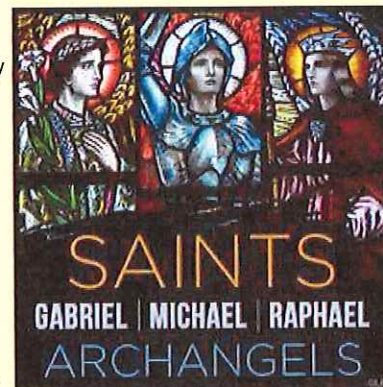

We celebrate the Feast of the Archangels - Sept. 29

On September 29, we celebrate the feast day of three important angels. These angels are referred to as "archangels" and are:



St. Michael which means "Who is like God?" and is mentioned four times in the Bible. He is the archangel that forced the devil out of heaven. We pray to him to help overcome temptations. He is the patron of the police and military.

St. Gabriel which means "Strength of God" is also mentioned four times in the Bible and is the archangel who appeared to Our Lady and asked if she would be the mother of Jesus. We pray to him to help us do God's will in our lives. He is the patron of messengers, journalists and communications.

St. Raphael which means "Healing of God" is mentioned only once in the Bible as the archangel who accompanied a blind man named Tobit on a journey. We pray to him to protect us in our travels. He is the patron of travelers especially those on a pilgrimage.

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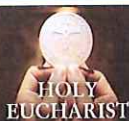
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
