St. Teresa of Avila Feast Day



We celebrate feast day of St. Teresa of Avila on Oct 15. She is the patron of headache sufferers and Catholic writers. St. Teresa was born March 28, 1515 and died on Oct 4, 1582.

She was beatified on April 24, 1614 and was canonized on March 12, 1622.

St. Teresa was the reformer of Carmel, mother of the Discalced Carmelite Nuns and Friars. She is the "spiritual mother" (as is engraved under her statue in the Vatican Basilica). St. Teresa is the patron of Catholic writers and was one of the first women, with Saint Catherine of Siena, to ever receive the title of Doctor of the Church (given this title in 1970).

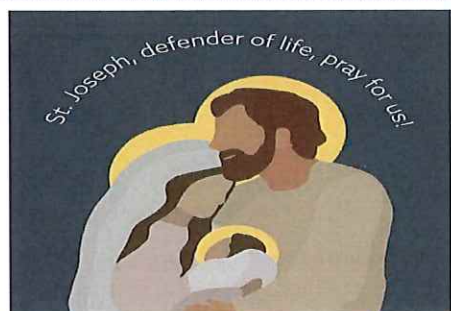

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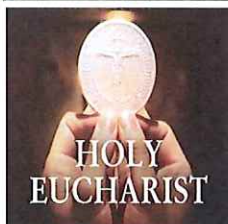
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
