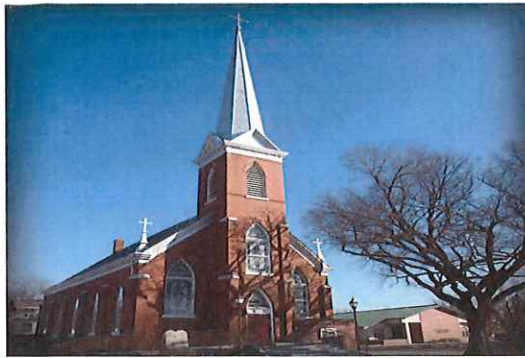
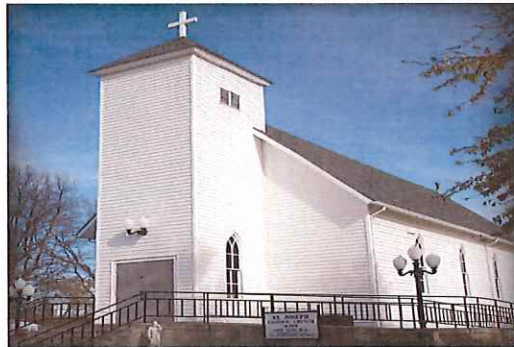
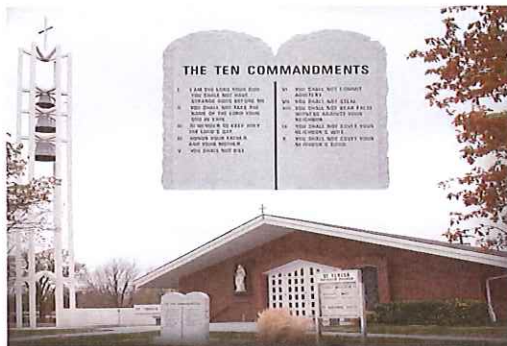

Pray the Rosary for Peace

In this month of October, as we contemplate with Mary the mysteries of Christ our Savior, let us deepen our prayer for peace: a prayer that becomes concrete solidarity with those people tormented by war.



The Holy Rosary

The Mysteries of the Rosary are a way to prayerfully focus on the life of Jesus. For this reason, it is said to pray and meditate on the Rosary and through Mary you will grow closer to her Son.



The Joyful Mysteries begin with Mary saying 'Yes Lord, Let it be' in the Annunciation and then continue with the visitation, birth, presentation and finding of Jesus teaching in the temple.

The Luminous Mysteries revolve around the adult life of Jesus in his baptism, the Wedding feast miracle at Cana, the proclamation of the Kingdom of God, the transfiguration and the institution of the Holy Eucharist.

The Sorrowful Mysteries deal with the last few hours of Jesus' life and then his death. These are sorrowful times for his Mother Mary, and as these decades are prayed you have a closer connection with the human suffering of both Jesus and Mary.

The Glorious Mysteries revolve around the New Life of Jesus as he rises from the dead, Ascends into heaven and then waits to welcome his Mother Mary's assumption to be crowned Queen of Heaven and Earth.

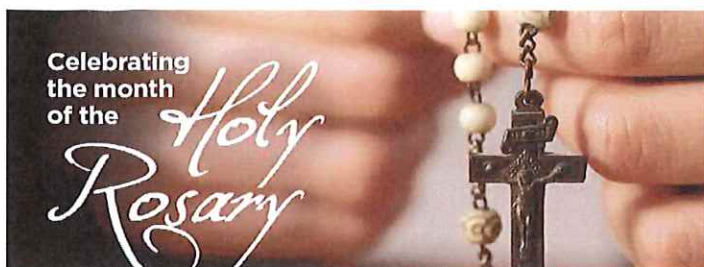
