Why Do We Pray for the Dead? The Bible tells us that "It is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins" (2 Maccabees 12:46), and especially in the month of November, the Catholic Church urges us to spend time in prayer for those who have gone before us. Prayer for the souls in Purgatory is a requirement of Christian charity, and it helps us to call to mind our own mortality. The Church offers a special plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, on All Souls Day (November 2), but the church also encourages us in a special way to continue to keep the Holy Souls in our prayers throughout the entire month of November.

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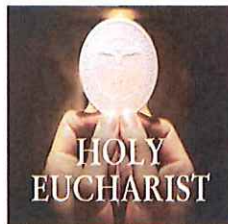
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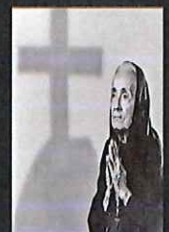
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
