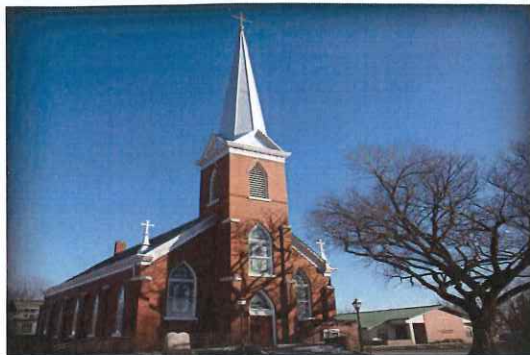
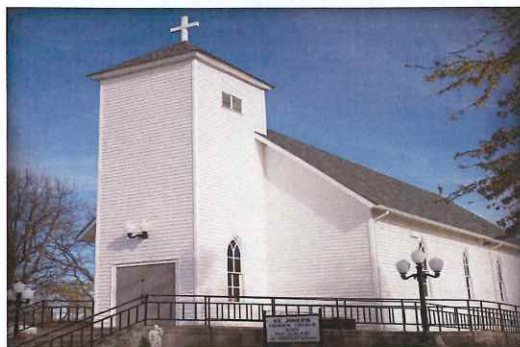




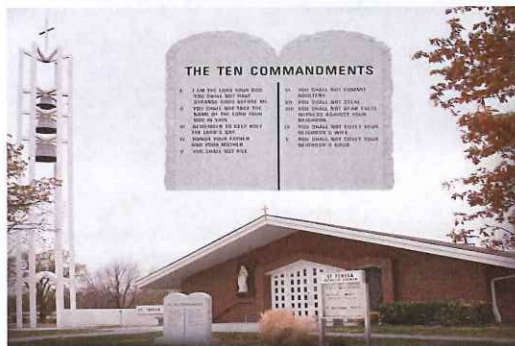

## Like the Magi ... Seek Him Everyday

We celebrate the feast of Epiphany this weekend where we focus on the Magi that have journeyed to come and offer homage to the King of Kings. In Sacred Scripture, we can see prophesies of a visit like this, Psalm 72:10-11 states:

*"May the kings of Tarshish and the islands bring tribute, the kings of Arabia and Seba offer gifts.  
May all kings bow before him, all nations serve him."*

and in Isaiah 60:3,6

*"Nations shall walk by your light, and kings by your shining radiance.  
Caravans of camels shall fill you, dromedaries from Midian and Ephah;  
All from Sheba shall come bearing gold and frankincense and proclaiming the praises of the Lord."*

The Magi also offer us an example to 'seek' the Lord as the new year starts to unfold. How will you open your heart to our Lord? Consider Adoration or a daily Mass during the week to re-center and connect yourself with Christ. Seek Him in Sacred Scripture or meditative prayer. Your journey to the Lord is a daily event!

May you, like the Magi so many years ago, seek to show your honor, respect, and worship to the King of Kings and Lord of Lords - Jesus Christ our Savior!

## THE SYMBOLIC GIFTS



### GOLD

The royal metal; signifies Jesus' Kingship (hence, the gift for a king).



### FRANKINCENSE

Symbol of prayer; signifies Jesus as the High Priest/Mediator between God and man (hence, the gift for a priest).



### MYRRH

A burial ointment; meaning that Jesus had to die for the salvation of all (hence, gift for one who would die).

*All the earth shall bow down before you,  
O God, and shall sing to you,  
shall sing to your name,  
O Most High!*

Psalm 66



As we focus on the Baptism of Our Lord, we have a wonderful paragraph from the Catechism (CCC 536):

*"The baptism of Jesus is on his part the acceptance and inauguration of his mission as God's suffering Servant. He allows himself to be numbered among sinners; he is already "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world". Already he is anticipating the "baptism" of his bloody death. Already he is coming to "fulfil all righteousness", that is, he is submitting himself entirely to his Father's will: out of love he consents to this baptism of death for the remission of our sins. The Father's voice responds to the Son's acceptance, proclaiming his entire delight in his Son. The Spirit whom Jesus possessed in fullness from his conception comes to "rest on him". Jesus will be the source of the Spirit for all mankind. At his baptism "the heavens were opened" - the heavens that Adam's sin had closed - and the waters were sanctified by the descent of Jesus and the Spirit, a prelude to the new creation."*

As we meditate upon these words, we can see what a blessed gift we have been given in Jesus – Eternal Life – and what great love God has for each of us – giving the world His baptized Son!

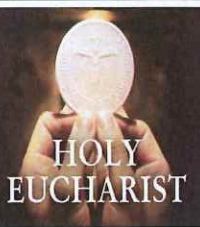

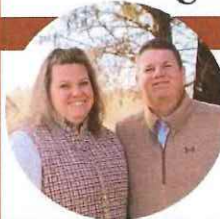
