Your Lenten Journey

The season of Lent in preparation for Easter is a good time to reflect on the precepts of the Church.

How are the precepts of the Church described? The Catechism describes them as "positive laws... meant to guarantee to the faithful the very necessary minimum in the spirit of prayer and moral effort, in the growth of love of God and neighbor."

What are the precepts of the Church?

There are five of them:

- 1) Attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor
- 2) Confess your sins at least once a year
- 3) Receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least once during the Easter season
- 4) Observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church
- 5) Help to provide for the needs of the Church

All year long we have the opportunity to fulfil these precepts, but it can be especially rewarding during the season of Lent as we prepare for the Easter celebration with a new spirit and a clean heart.

May your Lenten Journey be a time where Jesus is revealed more fully to you and may you glory in His presence and love.

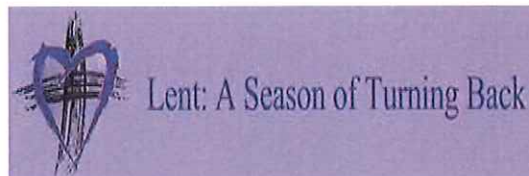

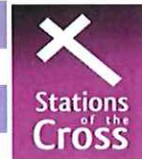

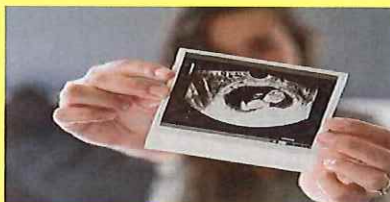
