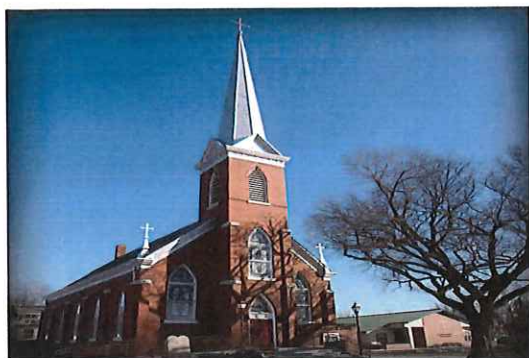
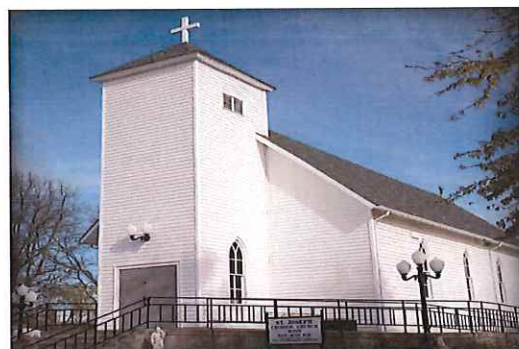
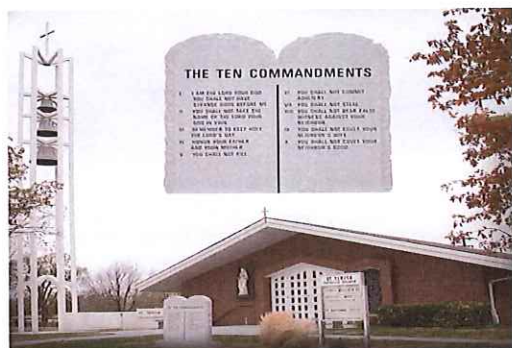

## ***His Mercy Endures Forever***

The Octave of Easter concludes this weekend with the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Divine Mercy image is a beautiful image of the Risen Lord pointing to the wound in his side and to his Sacred Heart in which the blood and water are flowing out in the white and red rays of shining light.

We encourage everyone to gather in prayer and receive the outpouring of Christ's abundant mercy and recite the Divine Mercy Chaplet as an individual as or a family at the 3 o'clock hour each day or sometime throughout the day. The three o'clock hour is important to our faith, as this is the hour in which our Lord died upon the cross.

Praise God in His infinite Mercy!

Recite this chaplet on rosary beads.

### **The Divine Mercy Chaplet**

#### Beginning Cross:

You expired, Jesus but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat the next lines 3 times on first bead)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You.

Next 3 beads: 1st bead Our Father.....  
2nd bead Hail Mary.....  
3rd bead Apostles Creed

#### On the Our Father beads recite:

Eternal Father, I offer You, the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

#### On the Hail Mary beads recite:

For the sake of his sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Conclusion (Repeat the next prayer 3 times): Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

#### Final Prayer:

Eternal God, in Whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us, and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we might not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen

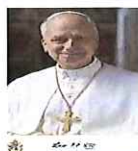

- ♦ **For responsible use of technology.** Let us pray for technology that serves human needs without replacing real relationships, respecting human dignity and aiding those in crisis.



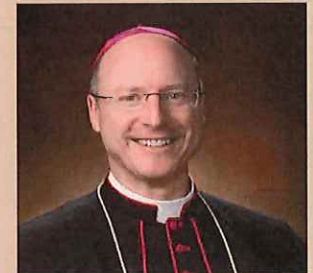

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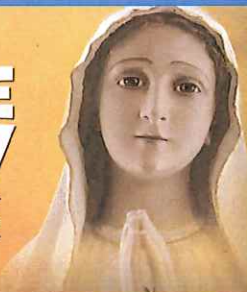
