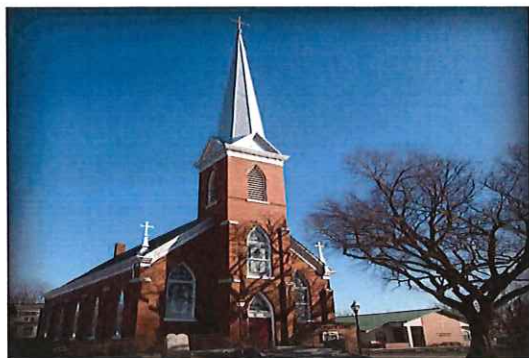
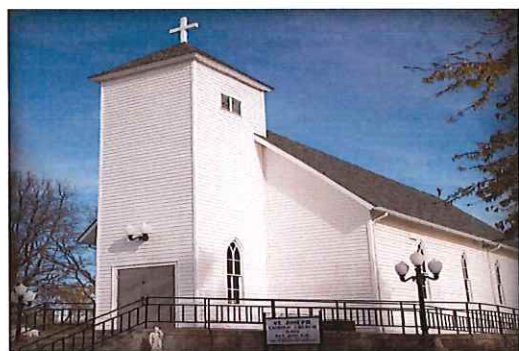

One of the great gifts we have - besides Holy Eucharist - is our time we can spend with Jesus in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

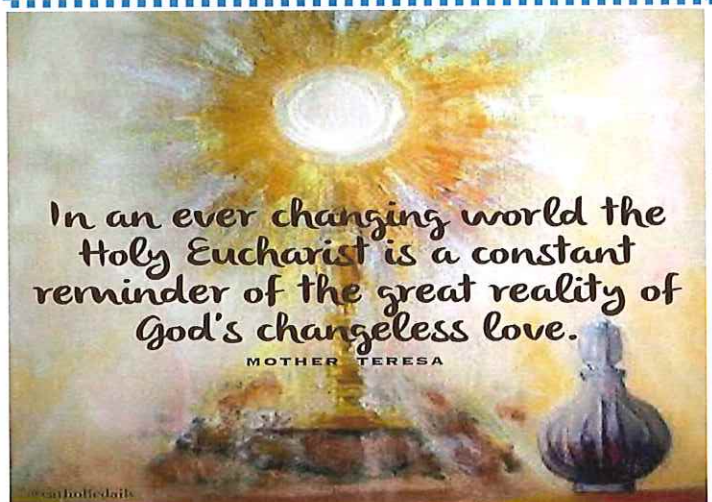
We believe that the Body and Blood is Christ and as we Adore Him, we can focus on the fact that God dwells alive in us through the Eucharist.

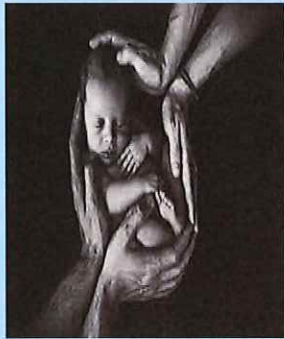

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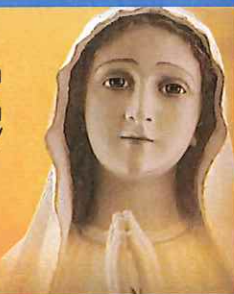
