The Sacred Heart of Jesus that began beating in the womb of the Blessed Virgin more than 2,000 years ago still beats today in the glorified humanity of the Risen Christ. We cannot contemplate such a holy and merciful image with indifference or ingratitude. One look at Jesus' heart should melt us, convert us and inspire us to give our hearts in return. Sacred Heart devotion is not magic or some automatic ticket to heaven; it is a sacred way for us to encounter the fullness of the Gospel and the good news of God's saving love poured out for us in Jesus Christ. That we will fall ever more deeply in love with Him and live out that transforming and redemptive relationship in every detail of our lives. This devotion unites our minds, hearts and wills in one great act of oblation, a total gift of the self to the One who loves us and has first offered himself completely to and for us.
